	<a href="#">IRS Free File Program</a>	Everyone (choices vary by adjusted gross income)
	Choose from a range of online filing companies or use Free File Fillable Forms (IRS)	
<b>FAMILIES WITH MINOR CHILDREN</b>	<a href="#">DSHS: Temporary Assistance for Needy Families</a>	People caring for minor children (usually under 18)
	Temporary cash assistance with additional supportive services to help find long-term solutions	
	<a href="#">DSHS: Pregnant Women Assistance</a>	Pregnant adults disqualified from TANF
	Temporary cash assistance with additional supportive services to help find long-term solutions	
	<a href="#">Division of Child Support (DCS)</a>	Parents/guardians of minor children (under age 18)
	Apply for or modify existing child support orders; establish paternity	
	<a href="#">DCS Alternative Solutions</a>	Non-custodial parents with an open DCS case in arrears
	Connects non-custodial parents to resources and possible help with lowering arrears debts, suspended licenses, etc.	
	<a href="#">Social Security: Survivors</a>	For minor children, surviving spouses/divorced spouses of Social Security payers
<b>AID FOR WORKERS</b>	Social Security benefits paid to surviving widow(er(s) and dependent(s) of deceased/disabled Social Security payers	
	<a href="#">ESD: Unemployment Compensation</a>	Eligible workers 18+ with no-fault job loss
	Weekly cash payments to replace income loss, job training and job search assistance	
	<a href="#">L&amp;I: Workers' Compensation</a>	Eligible workers injured on the job
	Cash payments to replace income loss, medical treatment reimbursement	
	<a href="#">ESD: WA Paid Family &amp; Medical Leave</a>	Eligible workers temporarily unable to work due to illness/injury
<b>AID FOR WORKERS</b>	Cash payments to replace income loss up to 12 weeks - for worker's injury/illness or family emergency	

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<b>TEMPORARY CASH ASSISTANCE</b>	<a href="#">DSHS: Refugee Cash Assistance</a>	Refugees and Asylees in first 8 months of US residency
	Monthly cash assistance up to 8 months, job training and readiness, education, support services	
	<a href="#">DSHS: Aged, Blind, or Disabled Cash Assistance (ABD)</a>	Adults 18+ determined disabled, blind, or age 65+
	Monthly cash assistance, SSI/Social Security facilitation, Housing & Essential Needs (HEN) referral, supportive services	
<b>DISABILITY/RETIREMENT</b>	<a href="#">Social Security: Survivors</a>	For minor children, surviving spouses/divorced spouses of Social Security payers
	Social Security benefits paid to surviving widow/er(s) and dependent(s) of deceased/disabled Social Security payers	
	<a href="#">SSA: Disability - Supplement Security Income (SSI)</a>	People 65+, or determined blind or disabled, without sufficient work quarters
	Monthly cash payments (if income-eligible), full Medicaid coverage	
	<a href="#">SSA: Disability - Social Security Disability (SSDI)</a>	People under 65, determined blind or disabled, with sufficient work quarters
	Monthly cash payments (if income-eligible), Medicare coverage after 24-month waiting period	
	<a href="#">SSA: Retirement</a>	People aged 62 (early) or 66-67 (depends on year of birth)
	Monthly cash payments (depending on lifetime Social Security taxes paid, and when you apply); may have Medicare waiting period	
	<a href="#">Veterans Administration</a>	Eligible retired and disabled veterans
	Monthly cash payments for disability, retirement, or other compensation, depending on eligibility	
	<a href="#">Railroad Retirement Board</a>	Retired, disabled or temporarily incapacitated workers, laid-off workers, and families
	Cash assistance for retirement, disability, worker's compensation, unemployment compensation, and survivor benefits
